1. Devils Marbles Conservation Reserve

Meander through the Devils Marbles - a collection of gigantic rounded granite boulders, many precariously balancing on top of one another. [www.nt.gov.au]

2. Kakadu National Park

Explore Kakadu National Park - a world-class visitor destination - identified as a key element of one of Australia's National Landscapes. [www.environment.gov.au]

3. Uluru (Ayers Rock)

Be amazed by Uluru, (Ayers Rock) - a large sandstone rock formation in the southern part of the Northern Territory. [www.uluru.com]

4. The Olgas (Kata Tjuta)

Be surprised by the Olgas, 30km from Uluru - made up of 36 rounded domes with the tallest (Mt. Olga) being 200m higher than Uluru. [www.australianexplorer.com]

5. Crocodylus Park

6. Sounds of Starlight Theatre

Experience the outback on a musical and visual journey, in an air-conditioned theatre in the heart of Alice Springs. [www.soundsofstarlight.com]

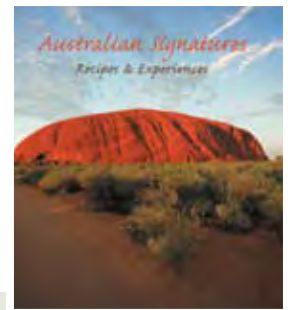
7. Butterfly Gorge Nature Park
